To model a more just, peaceful and sustainable way of living, working, and organizing ourselves in order that we bring about the change we so deeply desire in the world.

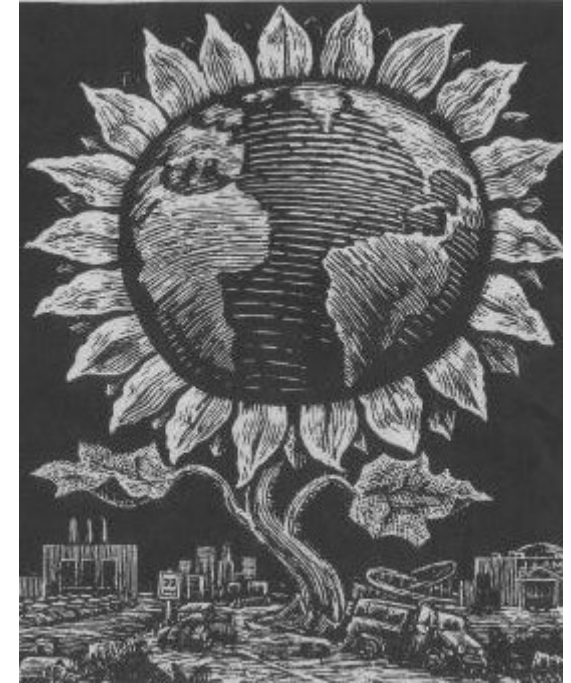
To facilitate communication, cooperation and sharing of information and resources statewide, nationally, and globally.
